1. OPENING

Leader: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

With the support of his prayers may we come to share the glory of Your children in the kingdom of Heaven. We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. **All:** Amen.

2. READINGS

First Reading: 2 Samuel 7:4-5, 12-24,16

Reader: The Lord spoke to Nathan and said: "Go, tell my servant David, 'When your time comes and you rest with your ancestors, I will raise up your heir after you, sprung from your loins, and I will make his kingdom firm. It is he who shall build a house for my name. And I will make his royal throne firm forever. I will be a father to him, and he shall be a son to me. Your house and your kingdom shall endure forever before me; your throne shall stand firm forever.'''

Reader: The Word of the Lord. **All:** Thanks be to God.

Second Reading: 2 Timothy 4: 7-8

Reader: I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day—and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.

Reader: The Word of the Lord. **All:** Thanks be to God.

Leader: Blessed are those who dwell in your house, O Lord; **All:** they never cease to praise you (Psalm 84:5).

GOSPEL: Matthew 1:16, 18-21, 24

Reader: Jacob was the father of Joseph, the husband of Mary. Of her was born Jesus who is called the Christ. Now this is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about. When his mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, but before they lived together, she was found with child through the Holy Spirit. Joseph her husband, since he was a righteous man, yet unwilling to expose her to shame, decided to divorce her quietly. Such was his intention when, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her. She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." Leader: O God, bless us as we crown this image of the most chaste spouse of your Mother.

All: We confess Christ to be the King of creation, Mary to be our Queen, and may we call upon Joseph to be our Prince and Patron. May we walk in their likeness spending ourselves for the sake of others. Content with our place in this life may we one day hear your voice inviting us to take our place in Heaven and receive the crown of victory.
